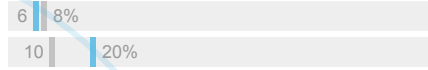

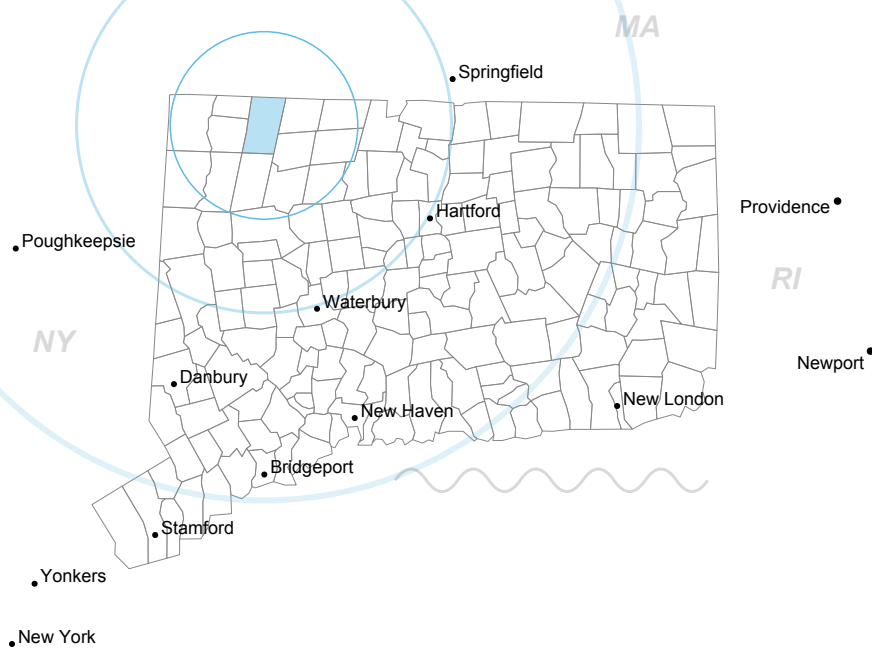
Unemployment Rate

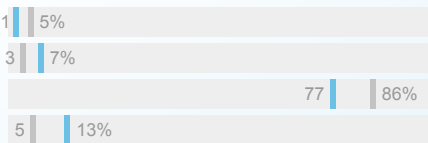
